GENERAL ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS FOR ALL DEPARTMENTS IN THE FACULTY

- (i) Five ‘O’ Level credits in not more than two (2) sitting; and these must be in subjects as specified by the respective Departments.
- (ii) Commerce, Book Keeping, and Financial Accounting are not acceptable in any of the Social Sciences Departments both at UTME and ‘O’ Level.

Department of Demography and Social Statistics

- (i) UTME Subjects: English Language, Mathematics, Economics, and any one of
 - a. Government
 - b. Geography
 - c. Physics/Chemistry/Biology
- (ii) ‘O’ Level Requirements: English Language, Mathematics, Economics, Geography/Government, and any one from History/Biology/Physics/Chemistry/Agricultural Science/ Literature-in-English/Yoruba/Igbo/Hausa/CRS/IRK/Computer Studies/Further Mathematics/Civic Education/Data Processing.

Department of Economics

- (i) UTME Subjects: English Language, Mathematics, Economics, Geography or Government.
- (ii) ‘O’ Level Requirements: English Language, Mathematics, Economics, Geography/Government, any one of: History/CRS/IRK/Yoruba/Igbo/Hausa/Literature-in-English/Chemistry/Physics/Biology/Agricultural Science/Further Mathematics/Civic Education/Computer Studies/Data Processing.

Department of Geography

- (i) UTME Subjects: English Language, Geography, and any two from:
 - a. Economics
 - b. Government
 - c. Mathematics
 - d. Physics
 - e. Chemistry
 - f. Biology/Agricultural Science.
- “O” Level Requirements: English Language, Mathematics, Geography, and any two subjects from: Economics, Government, Biology/Agricultural Science, Chemistry, Physics, History/Literature-in-English/Yoruba/Igbo/Hausa/CRS/IRS, Civic Education, Computer Studies, Data Processing/Animal Husbandry.

Department of Political Science

- Political Science Programme

- (i) UTME Subjects: English Language, Government, and any two from: Economics, Geography, Literature-in-English, CRS/IRS, Mathematics.
- (ii) 'O' Level Requirements: English Language, Mathematics, Government, and any two of the following subjects: Economics, Geography, Literature-in-English, CRS/IRS, Yoruba/Igbo/Hausa, History, Civic Education, Data Processing, Computer Studies, Physics/Chemistry/Biology/Agricultural Science.

- Politics, Philosophy and Economics (PPE) Programme:

- (i) UTME Subjects: English Language, Government, Economics and any one from: Geography, Literature-in-English, CRS/IRS, Mathematics.
- (ii) 'O' Level Requirements: English Language, Mathematics, Government, Economics, and one of the following subjects: Geography, Literature in English, CRS/IRS, Yoruba/Igbo/Hausa, History, Civic Education, Data Processing, Computer Studies, Physics/Chemistry/ Biology/Agricultural Science.

Department of Psychology

- (i) UTME Subjects: English Language and any three from: Mathematics, Economics, Government, Geography, Physics, Chemistry, Biology.
- (ii) 'O' Level Requirements: English Language, Mathematics, Biology and any other two (2) subjects from the following: Economics, Government, Geography, Physics, Chemistry, History, Literature-in-English, Yoruba/Igbo/Hausa, CRS/IRS, Agricultural Science, Civic Education, Data Processing, Computer Studies.

Department of Sociology and Anthropology

- (i) UTME Subjects: English Language, Mathematics and any two from:
 - a. Literature-in-English
 - b. Geography
 - c. CRS/IRS
 - d. Government
 - e. History
 - f. Economics
- (ii) 'O' Level Requirements: English Language, Mathematics, and any three of the following subjects: Economics, Government, Geography, Literature-in-English, Yoruba/Igbo/Hausa, Physics, Chemistry, IRS/CRS, History, Visual Arts, Music, Biology, Agricultural Science, Civic, Education, Data Processing, Computer Studies.
