(3) OPENING REMARKS BY THE REGISTRAR

Section 42(2), Statute 17(1) of the Second Schedule of Obafemi Awolowo University (Transitional Provisions) Act CAP 02, Laws of the Federation of Nigeria, 2004 Stipulates that "A Convocation for the conferment of degrees and other academic titles and distinctions of the University shall be held normally once every year at such a time and place as shall be determined by the Senate. The degrees, academic titles and distinctions shall be conferred by the person presiding."

Statute 17(2) also stipulates that "A Convocation shall be presided over by the Chancellor or, in his absence, by the Vice-Chancellor or, in the absence of both the Chancellor and Vice-Chancellor, by the Deputy Vice-Chancellor."




